

Projects with Public Outcomes

This category is open to *individuals, groups and organisations* that meet the Australia Council's general eligibility criteria.

Organisations **currently** in receipt of Community Partnerships multi-year or annual funding and individuals in receipt of an Australia Council fellowship or Creative Producer grant may **not** apply to this category.

ABOUT

- This category provides funding between **\$20,000 - \$35,000**
- It is designed for one off projects that **must have a public outcome** and involve collaborations with a range of cross-sectoral partners.
- 'Cross-sectoral partners' refer to individual and organisational partnerships from arts and non arts-sectors that will help make the project happen. Projects in this category must show that they have applied for co-funding from sources other than the Australia Council.
- If co-funding is not secured, the Committee may decide to withdraw the offer or it may determine to give seed funding to assist securing other co funding opportunities.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Evidence of community engagement in the creative and developmental aspects of the project
- Innovation and excellence in community arts and cultural development outcomes
- The capacity and skills of artists and/or facilitators to achieve the project outcomes
- Effective project planning including budget planning, use of resources, cross-sectoral partnerships and evaluation
- Quality of the developmental outcomes for communities while addressing one or more of the Community Partnerships priority areas (regional Australia, disability, young people, cultural diversity, emerging communities, Indigenous people, remote Indigenous communities, and specific critical social and cultural issues requiring focused attention).
