

APPENDIX A

Occupation classification used in the Census of Population and Housing

For the 2001 Census of Population and Housing, occupations were classified to the most detailed (six-digit) level of the 1997 Australian Standard Classification of Occupations (ASCO). If a Census response lacked adequate information for it to be coded to the six-digit occupation level, it was coded to a 'not further defined' category (for example designers and illustrators n.f.d.) with zeroes in the fifth and sixth digit positions of the ASCO code.

Cultural occupations were selected on the basis of inclusion in the occupation classification in the Australian Culture and Leisure Classifications (ACLCL). The ACLCL occupation categories are directly comparable to the ASCO occupation categories.

APPENDIX C

Artistic industry classifications

ANZSIC

The Australian and New Zealand Standard Industrial Classification (ANZSIC) was developed for the production and analysis of industry statistics. One aim was to group businesses that carried out similar economic activities.

ACLCL

The industry classification of the Australian Culture and Leisure Classification (ACLCL) was developed as an alternative view to ANZSIC. This industry classification groups businesses whose main activities are to produce goods or provide services which are intended for use by people participating in culture or leisure activities. It also groups businesses which provide support services to these businesses.

Comparative table

The table opposite illustrates how ANZSIC industry classes correspond to ACLCL industry classes which are classified as cultural.

A (p) in the table indicates partial correspondence between classes.
